Points for Prayer

This week the King will be crowned: We take the opportunity to pray for our nation.

Monday 1st May

We are currently living through a period of as poor **industrial relations** as we have seen in a generation. Pray for relations between industry and unions as well as government and public sector workers. Pray for an openness to compromise, but also fairness.

Tuesday 2nd May

Confidence in the **police** has been shaken through a number of instances where individual officers' standards have fallen well short of expectations. Pray for the police, pray for senior officers as they implement changes to culture. Pray also for the officers who must deal with public mistrust while preforming their duties.

Wednesday 3rd May

The Secretary of State has been forced to introduce a budget for Northern Ireland because of a lack of devolved government. Pray for the **civil servants** who now must implement what is both unpopular and severe. Give wisdom that they will do what is right and just.

Thursday 4th May

The ongoing crisis of government at **Stormont** continues to impact much of everyday life in Northern Ireland. Pray for a way forward and an agreement that sees a restoration of the power sharing arrangements.

Friday 5th May

Much has been made of the relationships within the **Royal Family**. Pray for the Royal Family ask God for unity and a healing of all broken relationships.

Saturday 6th May

Pray for the **King**. Ask that today would not only be a celebration but a day of deep Christian significance as he is anointed with oil and the empowering of the Holy Spirit is sought for his life and rule. Pray that the King would be an influence for good and a witness to Jesus as his mother was.

Sunday 7th May

Today we celebrate the **Sacrament of Communion**. Pray that our services and time together would be incredibly significant; that it would be a time of renewing and blessing. Pray for spiritual growth within our congregation.
