## Points for Prayer

We hope you find these prayer points useful.

### **Monday 29<sup>th</sup> May**

The work begins today for everything that will happen on Sunday morning. The church is being cleaned, the diary is being compiled, the music is being prepared as is the sermon and the children's programme. Pray for all the preparation that goes into every Sunday. Ask that God would be speaking, guiding and leading in order that we would come to church with a sense of expectation.

### **Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> May**

Who do you normally sit beside in church? Why not take time today to pray for them. Thank God for them and ask that he would bless them with his peace, presence and assurance.

### **Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> May**

There are a lot of people who are unwell at the moment. Pray for our congregation, ask God for healing for those who are in hospital or receiving treatments. Pray for their families as they worry and travel back and forth visiting.

### **Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> June**

Church should be a place of community. Pray for all that happens in our church designed at bringing people closer together. Pray that we would grow closer to God and in doing so, closer to one another.

### **Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> June**

Church should be a place of challenge. Pray that as we come Sunday by Sunday that we would face some uncomfortable truths about how we are living in order that we would learn to walk more closely with God. Pray also that we would know no matter how much we are challenged by God, that in Christ Jesus we are accepted and will never be turned away.

### **Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> June**

Thank God for Heather and the team of musicians and singers as they prepare to lead us in our worship. Pray that as we worship that we would have a very real sense of God's blessing and presence.

### **Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> June**

Pray for this morning's service. Pray that God would make everything we do meaningful and that our lives would be transformed through the reading and preaching of his word by the power of his Spirit.
