
<u>Please note</u> the Church Office will be closed this week. It will re-open on Wednesday 26th June

Points for Prayer

Sunday 16th June

This morning, we will be continuing to think about the grace of God and how we know this grace through his patience. Take time to thank God that he is patient with us but also take time to ask God to show us those areas of our lives where we are less than patient with others.

Monday 17th June

The General Assembly takes place this week, pray for the work of the assembly. Ask God that all who attend and lead the debates will know wisdom and that good decisions would be made. Pray that this year's assembly would not draw attention to itself but point only towards the glory of God.

Tuesday 18th June

The world continues to groan under the pressures and strains of war. We have people connected to our congregation who have fled war in various different places.
