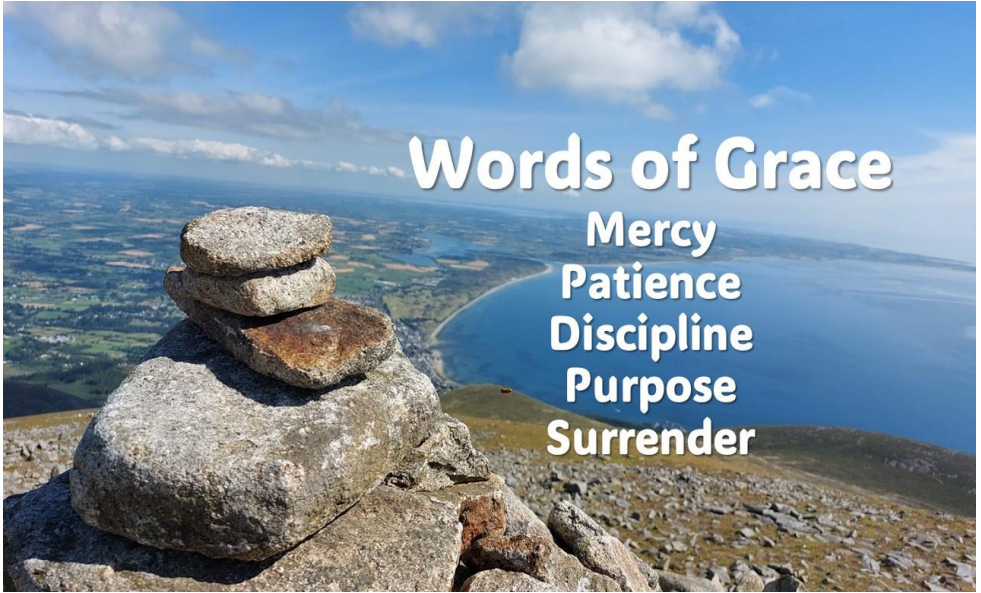

Sunday 7 July

- **Moderator** | Pray for the Moderator as he visits the congregation of Newcastle PC and also River House.
