### CONGREGATIONAL MEETING on Sunday 13th October

**Concerning the co-option of an elder paragraph 181 (2) of the code states:** The approval of the congregation shall be obtained by announcing the Session's intention to co-opt on two successive Sundays; and if, at a meeting of the congregation, approval be not then unanimous, the Session shall fix a day to take the opinion of the voters, when unless two-thirds of those then voting approve they shall not proceed with the co-option.

It was announced last Sunday (29<sup>th</sup>) and again this Sunday (6<sup>th</sup>) that a meeting of the congregation will be held on **Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> October** after morning worship.

# Points for Prayer

#### Sunday 6th October
