# The visions of Daniel



## Reflections

### **Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> January**

Read Galatians 6:7. As we gather for worship this morning take time to reflect on the place we give God in our lives. Is our worship heartfelt, or do we pay lip service only?

### **Monday 20<sup>th</sup> January**

Read James 4:8. How often do we really come before God in confession, or how much does our life really change through repentance? Take time to think about James 4:8 and *draw near to God* again through a time of honest prayer.

### **Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> January**

Read Luke 10:9. Jesus sent the 72 out with very clear instructions. Take time today to pray about how we are to go into our world. When was the last time we prayed with people who were sick or talked to someone about the kingdom of God drawing near? Pray that we would be more like those Jesus sent out.

### **Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> January**

Read John 14:13. Take time today to pray about the needs of our church. Leaders are required in many areas of church life. Instead of simply praying for more leaders, why not pray that God would equip and call you to serve his church.

### **Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> January**

Read Psalm 119:103. Are we experiencing and enjoying the sweetness of God's word, is it part of our daily diet? The bible study meets tonight why not come and feast on the sweetness with others.

### **Friday 24<sup>th</sup> January**

Read Proverbs 4:23. In what ways are we guarding our hearts? The only way to guard the heart is to surround it and fill it with the word of God and prayer. Take seriously the importance of being immersed in scripture and prayer.

### **Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> January**

Read Ecclesiastes 4:12. A chord of three strands is not easily broken. Are we bound up in God, by the word of God and through the Spirit of God. A strong faith is not measured in how well we can pray, or our ability to teach scripture. A strong faith is one that is bound to God, dependant on God through Jesus Christ, by his Spirit.
