RE: THE BILL TO LEGALISE ASSISTED SUICIDE

The Christian lobby organisation, CARE, would like to update you on this. The Bill has now been given to a Public Bill Committee, made up of 23 MPs, who will scrutinise it. The Committee will begin formal scrutiny of the Bill in the next couple of weeks, and it has launched a call for evidence, which seeks specific input from people with "relevant expertise".

MPs want to hear from people with specific knowledge, including medical professionals, those with legal knowledge and expertise, those with a relevant academic background (e.g. ethics), those who work with vulnerable adults, and those with experience of living with or caring for someone living with a terminal diagnosis. Reflections

Sunday 26th January

Read Isaiah 52:7. This morning take time to pray for **John Hanna** as he leads us in worship and proclaims the word of God. Consider how you can proclaim this good news in your own context.

Monday 27th January

Read Romans 10:14. Reflect on this verse and ask God to show you how to tell others about Jesus Christ. Take time to pray that we would see people coming to faith because they have heard others talk about faith in Jesus.

Tuesday 28th January

Read Psalm 139:23-24. Ask God to search your own heart. What are the things that act as a barrier between us and God, what are the things that cause us to

hold back in sharing our faith in Christ, or make us shy away from a more intimate relationship with the Lord?

Wednesday 29th January

Read 2 Corinthians 5:17. Take time to remind yourself this morning that in Christ you are a new creation, the old has gone the new has come. When something that belongs with the old causes you to shy away from sharing your faith, why not commit this verse to memory in order to remind yourself that the new has come.

Thursday 30th January

Read John 15:4. Reflect on the promise that as you seek the Lord today in prayer, so Christ has promised to remain not only with you, but in you. Thank God for the closeness of his relationship with us, the security and peace of his being in us.

Friday 31st January

Read Jeremiah 15:16. We bear the name of Christ as we identify as Christian. Are we like Jeremiah, do we feed on the words of Jesus, are they a delight to us? Take time to pray that as you read your bible this morning so the words would be a delight, that they would nourish.

Saturday 1st February

Read Mark 8:27. As we prepare for worship tomorrow ask yourself this simple question: Who is Jesus? When we stand to sing, when we settle ourselves to pray or when we read from scripture — what does it all mean, who is the one we are worshipping? Peter announced Jesus to be the Messiah the Son of God. Is Jesus the one we have been waiting for?
