Points for Prayer

Reflections

Sunday 9th February

Read Psalm 122. There is so much in this Psalm to help us prepare for worship today. Reflect on the significance of God's people meeting together, the invitation into God's house, his presence. Note also the connection between coming together for worship and praying for the peace of Jerusalem. Pray for the church, pray for Portstewart, pray that as we come together Sunday by Sunday, we would have that sense of joy and anticipation as to what God is going to do.

Monday 10th February

Read John 13: 3-5. Jesus was confident of who he was and so he was able to humble himself and serve his disciples. Pray that we would know who we are in Christ. That our place in the Kingdom of God is secure because of Christ – in order that we would be released to serve one another in humility and love.

Tuesday 11th February

Read John Psalm 68:11. Pray for our PW who meet tonight. Pray that they would be the mighty throng of woman who proclaim the word of God.

Wednesday 12th February

Read Psalm 134. Take time to pray for those leaders within our church who regularly minister to you. Pray that God would send more workers, more leaders to support those already working within our church. Ask God if he is sending you to serve in some way.

Thursday 13th February

Read Joel 2:12. What is the purpose of the Church? Surely the purpose of the church is to call a wayward people to return to the Lord. Reflect on Joel 2:12 and ask in what ways do we need to return to the Lord but also ask how we are calling on others to return to the Lord.

Friday 14th February

Read 1 John 4:19. On valentine's day reflect on why it is we are able to love. Read also Romans 5:8 and reflect on how God demonstrates his love for us.

Saturday 15th February

Read 1 Timothy 5:17. Take time this morning to pray for our Kirk Session. Pray for wisdom and boldness as they lead the congregation forward. Ask how you can encourage your elder. Pray also for **Wesley Quinn** as he prepares to preach from God's word tomorrow morning.
