Points for Prayer

Reflections

Sunday 23rd March

Read 1 Corinthians 4:20. Pray that this morning's service will have been much more than mere words. Pray that we would all reflect on the words of scripture, the words of the praises we sang and the words of the prayers we prayed – ask that God would inhabit all of these words by his Spirit so that they might have power to change and transform each of us.

Monday 24th March

Read Proverbs 27:17. The Men's Shed continues to meet in our Annex Building. Pray for the men of our town and our church. Pray that as they meet together so iron would sharpen iron. That they would support and encourage one another.

Tuesday 25th March

Read 1 Corinthians 16:13-14. Pray specifically for the men in our church. Pray for Godly men to step forward and take a more prominent role in leadership within the church.

Wednesday 26th March

Read Titus 2: 2-8. This morning, pray for the young men and boys in our church. Pray that they would find in the church role models to follow in terms of behaviour but also in the spiritual disciplines of prayer and bible study.

Thursday 27th March

Read Joel 2: 28-29. The prophet Joel promised that God would pour out his Spirit on men and women, young and old, a promise fulfilled on the Day of Pentecost. This morning, pray for an outpouring of God's Spirit on our church. Pray especially that men would know the power of God.

Friday 28th March

Throughout scripture God is described as Father. The nature of his relationship with us is that of a Father who loves his children. Take time today to pray for the fathers in our congregation. Pray for the relationships they have with their children. Pray especially for those fathers who are estranged or separated from their children. Ephesians 6:4

Saturday 29th March

Read Matthew 6: 22-23. Men and boys are bombarded with images that demean women and give a false picture of intimacy. Pray for the men and boys in our congregation that they would be protected from the readily available and accessible pornography industry. Pray that men and boys would learn what it is to value and cherish women.
